

**CSR SPENDING FOR THE F.Y. 2025-26, AS PER THE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

CSR Obligation worked out to be Rs. 1,20,19,645 (round off to Rs. 1,20,20,000) for the F.Y. 2025-26 which needed to be spent on CSR activities / projects i.e. 2% of the average net profits of the company during the three immediately preceding financial years which included the set-off of the excess amount of Rs.9,70,500 spent in F.Y. 2024-25.
